He was also trial counsel for RTDI in the personal injury and maritime litigation arising from the collision of a tug driven barge and a tourist duck boat on the Delaware River that involved 2 deaths and severe injuries to 35 passengers. In addition, he represented the Tropicana Casino in litigation arising from multiple deaths and numerous catastrophic injuries caused by a parking garage collapse during construction in Atlantic City. Bill is a graduate of Penn State University and the Widener University School of Law.






